The Hemispherectomy Foundation and Parker County Physical Therapy will host a 5K and 1-mile fun run/walk on **Saturday, May 14**. "Dreams on Wings" will honor Aledo's Jessie Hall, a second grader who underwent radical surgery in which one half of her brain was removed. All proceeds from the event will benefit The Hemispherectomy Foundation, a non-profit organization dedicated to providing emotional, financial and educational support for individuals and their families who have undergone or will undergo a hemispherectomy, or similar brain surgery.

The 2010 Dreams on Wings 5K was a great success! The foundation was able to raise just over \$10,000 for the children that we support. Best of all, 10 families with children that have undergone hemispherectomy surgery attended the race!



The 1-mile fun run will start at 8:00 a.m. followed by the 5K at 8:30 a.m. Both races will start at Parker County Physical Therapy located at 879 E. Eureka in Weatherford, Texas.

Individual awards will be given for overall and masters male and female winners, plus the top three male and female finishers in the following age groups: 5 and under, 6-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-29, 30-34, 35-39, 40-44, 45-49, 50-54, 55-59, 60-64 and 65+.
